MEMORANDUM FOR US Army Fort Belvoir Personnel

SUBJECT: Fort Belvoir Policy Memorandum #57, Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS)

1. REFERENCE:

a. Notice N JO 7210.891, U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration (Unmanned Aircraft Operations in the National Airspace System (NAS)), 25 November 2015.

b. Advisory Circular (AC) 91-57A, Federal Aviation Administration (Model Aircraft Operating Standards), 2 September 2015.

c. Public Law 112-95 (H.R. 658, Section 366) (The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Modernization and Reform Act of 2012), 14 February 2012.

d. Deputy Secretary of Defense Policy Memorandum 15-002, (Guidance for the Domestic Use of Unmanned Aircraft Systems), 17 February 2015.

2. PURPOSE: To provide restrictive guidance to all personnel, residents and individuals entering onto or within the Fort Belvoir area of responsibility (AOR) to include the Fort Belvoir North Area, MARK Center, Davison Army Airfield and Rivanna Station. This policy memorandum also provides guidance for the domestic use of unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) to ensure that Department of Defense (DoD) UAS are used in accordance with Federal Law and DoD policy, and to ensure the appropriate use of DoD UAS assets in domestic operations, training, exercises, and testing.

3. APPLICABILITY: This policy applies to all Department of the Army military (active component, and reserve component), other service component personnel, civilians (including visitors), contract personnel and base housing residents on Fort Belvoir.


4. POLICY: Use and operation of Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) on Fort Belvoir is prohibited due to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) designating the National Capital Region (NCR) as a "No Fly Zone." This includes, but is not limited to, parks and playground areas, ball fields, housing areas, basin area, training areas, open parking lots, golf course and airfields. All non-Army organizations or units on Fort Belvoir will incorporate this policy into their own command policies in accordance with Reference 1d.
