MEMORANDUM FOR US Army Fort Belvoir Personnel

SUBJECT: Fort Belvoir Policy Memorandum #33, Noise in McRee Barracks

1. PURPOSE. To establish reasonable noise levels within McRee Barracks to facilitate a comfortable living environment for residents.
2. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all military personnel and guests in McRee Barracks.
3. POLICY.
 - a. Quiet hours will be observed from 2200 – 0630 Sunday through Thursday and from 2300 – 0800 Friday and Saturday.
 - b. Music and noise will be kept to a minimum during the above quiet hours, so as not to disturb other individuals in the barracks. Music and noise will not be loud enough to be heard outside the individual's room when the room door is closed. This policy also applies to vibrations from electronic equipment.
 - c. A reasonable level of noise during normal duty hours is permitted; however, because there are shift workers in the barracks, the rule of thumb is to always be considerate of other occupants.
 - d. If violations occur, the complainant will ask the violator to reduce the noise. If the noise level continues, the complainant will contact the building Non-Commissioned Officer (NCO), if available. The Building NCO will ask the violator to reduce the noise. If the noise continues, the Building NCO will contact the military police who will investigate and log the incident. If the Building NCO is unavailable, the complainant may contact the military police.
 - e. The Garrison Command Sergeant Major will be notified of frequent violators of this policy and will meet with the violator and his/her First Sergeant or equivalent.
