

**MTMC POV PROCESSING CENTER

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Monday - Friday from 0800 Hours to 1600 Hours **EXCEPT HOLIDAYS.** TELEPHONE: For information call (410) 631-5751 or 1-800-631-5751. POV Turn in/pickup is done at commercial contractor PASHA located at 2100 Broening Hwy, Baltimore, MD. The MTMC information center Point Breeze Business Center is located in building 93, 2501 Broening Hwy, Baltimore MD.

DIRECTIONS TO TERMINAL

FROM THE NORTH:

From I-83, enter the Baltimore Beltway (I-695) and proceed to exit 33 (I-95 South). Proceed on I-95 South for approximately 3 1/2 miles. At this point the interstate will split, follow the signs directing you to East Baltimore and Truck Route S.E. Baltimore and marine Terminal signs. Stay on I-95 to Keith Ave., (Exit 56). At the first intersection after you exit, turn left onto Keith Avenue. Follow Keith Avenue for approx. .8 miles until it empties onto Broening Highway. Proceed on Broening Highway to Point Breeze Office complex on the right. The PASHA Center is directly across the street at 2501 Broening HWY. At this point turn left into the parking lot at the stop light just before the bridge crossing Colgate Creek and follow the signs.

FROM THE NORTHEAST:

Remain on I-95 South. (Baltimore/Washington) until "Keith Avenue", (Exit 56). Follow the same directions as from the North.

FROM THE WEST:

Approaching Baltimore on I-70, exit at 1895 South (Balt Beltway) at the Baltimore/ Glen Burnie exit (Exit 91A). Follow signs to Key Bridge/Dundalk. Cross the Key bridge and take the first exit after the toll booth (Exit 44 Dundalk Ave). Continue on Dundalk Ave until the split. Take the road to the left (Broening Hwy). Follow Broening across the bridge over Colgate Creek to the first light, turn right into the parking lot and follow the signs.

FROM THE SOUTH:

From I-295 North, take I-695 Glenn Burney Exit and follow I-695 to Key bridge/Dundalk. After crossing the Key bridge, follow the same directions as those from the West. From I-95 North: After passing through the Fort McHenry Tunnel, take the first exit after the toll booth (Exit 56 Keith Ave), then follow the same directions as those from the North.

ALTERNATE FROM THE SOUTH OR WEST:

Approaching Baltimore from the West or the South, I-95 I 295 and the Baltimore Tunnel Throughway (I-895) to the Harbor Tunnel can be used to reach the center, heading North on I-295 exit directly onto the Harbor Tunnel Throughway (I-895). From the west on I-70, take I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) and get off at the Balt. Glenn Burney Exit (Exit 91A) Travel South to I-695 and exit at the Harbor Tunnel Exit.

ALTERNATE FROM I-95 NORTH:

Take the I-695 Glenn Burney Exit and the Harbor Tunnel Through way (Exit 8A to I-895). After passing through the Harbor tunnel, take Holabird Ave to Broening Hwy. From this point follow the directions above from the North.

PREPARING VEHICLES FOR SHIPMENT

1. ENSURE THAT THE VEHICLE IS IN SAFE OPERATING CONDITION.
2. THE INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR SURFACES OF THE VEHICLE MUST BE CLEAN, ALL EXTERIOR SURFACES INCLUDING THE UNDERCARRIAGE MUST BE CLEAN AND FREE FROM SOIL AND FOREIGN MATTER BEFORE TURN-IN.
3. THE VEHICLE SHOULD HAVE NO MORE THAN ONE FOURTH TANK OF FUEL.
4. ENSURE THE COOLING SYSTEM IS SAFEGUARDED WITH ANTIFREEZE PROTECTION TO -20° FAHRENHEIT OR LOWER AS REQUIRED.
5. TURN-IN ONE COMPLETE SET OF KEYS INCLUDING GAS CAP KEYS, AND LUG NUT KEYS, IF APPLICABLE, AND RETAIN A SECOND COMPLETE SET OF KEYS FOR PICK-UP AT DESTINATION.

WHAT YOU MAY LEAVE IN YOUR VEHICLE

1. ENSURE ONLY AUTHORIZED ARTICLES REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE.
2. ITEMS CONSIDERED NORMAL VEHICLE TOOLS SUCH AS JACKS, TIRE IRONS, TIRE CHAINS, FIRE EXTINGUISHERS, TIRE INFLATORS, FIRST AID KIT, JUMPER CABLES, WARNING TRIANGLE AND BASIC HAND TOOLS MAY REMAIN IN THE VEHICLE.
3. SMALL ITEMS SUCH AS THERMOS BOTTLES, CAR CUSHIONS AND SMALL ITEMS FOR YOUR COMFORT AND CONVENIENCE DURING MOTOR TRIPS MAY BE SHIPPED WITH THE VEHICLE ONLY IF THE ITEMS FIT SECURELY WITHIN A CARTON APPROXIMATELY 24x16x12.
4. ONE SPARE TIRE AND TWO SNOW TIRES WITH WHEELS MAY REMAIN IN THE VEHICLE.

WHAT YOU MAY NOT LEAVE IN YOUR VEHICLE

1. ALL HOUSEHOLD ITEMS AND CAMPING EQUIPMENT MUST BE REMOVED.
2. ALL UNAUTHORIZED ACCESSORIES INCLUDING: MOBILE PHONES, CB AND SIMILAR RADIOS, TAPE DECKS, CD PLAYERS, TVs, AND VCRs.
3. ACCESSORIES NOT PERMANENTLY INSTALLED, AND OTHER HIGH VALUE ITEMS MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE TURNING IN THE VEHICLE FOR SHIPMENT.
4. THE SHIPMENT OF ANY FLAMMABLE OR HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES TO INCLUDE FLARES, WAXES, OILS, SOLVENTS AND POLISHES IN YOUR POV IS PROHIBITED. PLEASE DISPOSE OF THESE ITEMS BEFORE YOU TURN-IN YOUR VEHICLE FOR SHIPMENT.
5. PROPANE TANKS MUST BE EMPTIED AND CERTIFIED AS PURGED BY A LICENSED DEALER.
